



At Eaglequest Coyote Creek, we are committed to providing a safe environment where friends and family come together to learn, practice and play. Our staff and our community are very important to us and your safety remains our top priority

Over the last several weeks, we have been following the guidelines and procedures outlined by the local authorities and WHO, and we have been taking extra steps to provide a safe and welcoming environment for all guests. We want to share safety measures we have put in place to protect the health and safety of our community.

- We will be adhering to all current and potential future guidelines set out by the Province and the Minister of Health. Currently the maximum size event that we will be hosted at Coyote Creek is 250 people.
- We are conducting regular and frequent disinfecting of high-touch areas in our venues.
- We are supplying hand sanitizer throughout our location
- We are implementing illness prevention procedures with all staff as recommended by the local authorities and WHO, including frequent handwashing, avoiding contact with your eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands and avoiding close contact with people who are sick. We are refraining from hand shaking at this time.
- We are instructing staff who are exhibiting symptoms of illness to stay home or seek care from a medical provider when necessary.
- We are asking any customers who are feeling ill, have been in contact with someone who has recently travelled or are displaying signs of sickness to please refrain from visiting our property
